Rise Learning Center Covid-19 Response

The Rise Learning Center (RLC) has seen a recent increase in the number of positive Covid -19 cases. We are taking every precaution we can in the school itself, but we need to change a few schedules to increase our social distancing.

Starting on November 16, 2020, the Behavior Education High School and Middle School classrooms will become a hybrid schedule. Mr. Nelson's and Ms. Crabb's classes will be in attendance on Mondays and Tuesdays, starting on the 16th for Mr. Nelson's class, and the 23rd for Ms. Crabb's classroom. Mr. Wheeler's and Mr. Londeree's classes will be in attendance at the RLC on Thursdays and Fridays, the first day for Londeree being November 19th but for Wheeler the first in-person day will be the 20th. Students and staff will continue online or virtual learning the other three school days each week. Students will need to take their Chromebook home each day and bring them back when they attend. Wednesdays will be a cleaning day for these classrooms.

IF there are numerous classrooms of students and/or staff who are positive for Covid-19 or are directly exposed to other persons positive for Covid -19, and the classrooms must be quarantined per the Indiana State Department of Health or the Marion County Health Department, we will consider having those classrooms instructed virtually for 14 calendar days. This virtual assignment could be by department or by area as needed to control the possible spread. The length of the virtual instruction could be increased if the remaining classrooms also begin to exhibit positive Covid-19 or quarantines due to exposure to persons positive for Covid-19.
