Keep Our School Healthy!



Parents and Guardians,

To keep our students and staff healthy, please follow these guidelines when deciding if your child is well enough to attend school. Sending your child to school while they are sick puts everyone at risk of illness. Thank you for helping us maintain a healthy learning environment!

When Should Your Child Stay Home?

Fever/Chills/Generalized Body Aches

- **Stay Home:** If your child has a temperature of **100.4°F or higher**.
- **Return to School:** Once your child has been **fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication**.

Undiagnosed Rash

- **Stay Home:** If your child has a rash that is **spreading, oozing, or accompanied by fever**.
- **Return to School:** After a **physician determines the rash is non-contagious** and provides written clearance. Follow all physician guidelines for return.

Eye Discharge/Redness

- **Stay Home:** If your child has **eye discharge, crusting, or bright redness of the white of the eye**.
- **Return to School:** After **evaluation by a physician**, with a return-to-school note. If antibiotics are prescribed, your child must have **24 hours of treatment** before returning.

Vomiting or Diarrhea

- **Stay Home:** If your child has experienced **vomiting or diarrhea**.
- **Return to School:** Once your child has been **symptom-free for 24 hours without medication**.

Why Is This Important?

Keeping your child home when they're sick helps prevent the spread of illness and ensures that they can fully recover before returning to school. Thank you for your cooperation and commitment to keeping our school community healthy and thriving!

***Also, when you receive a call from RLC staff requesting your student be picked up due to illness, behavior, etc., please pick up within a timely manner of the call. Everyone should have an emergency back-up plan should you not be able to pick up at these times.*
